

SECTION IV - FIRE AND EXPLOSION HAZARD DATA

AN IGNITION SOURCE WHICH MAY RESULT IN A FLASH BACK TO THE SOURCE OF THE VAPORS.

SPECIAL FIREFIGHTING PROCEDURES: DO NOT BREATHE FUMES. WEAR SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS (PRESSURE DEMAND, MSHA/NOISH-APPROVED OR EQUIVALENT) AND FULL PROTECTIVE GEAR. WATER MAY SPREAD FIRE. WATER SPRAY SHOULD BE USED TO COOL CONTAINERS EXPOSED TO FIRE.

SECTION V - HEALTH HAZARD DATA

EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE: INHALATION: CAUSES RESPIRATORY IRRITATION. HARMFUL IF INHALED. EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES: EYE CONTACT: FLUSH WITH LARGE QUANTITIES OF WATER FOR 15 MINUTES. IF IRRITATION PERSISTS GET MEDICAL ATTENTION. SKIN CONTACT: REMOVE SATURATED CLOTHING. WASH WITH SOAP AND WATER. SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IF IRRITATION DEVELOPS. LAUNDER SATURATED CLOTHING AND CLEAN SHOES BEFORE REUSE. INHALATION: REMOVE TO FRESH AIR. GIVE ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION IF NECESSARY. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION. INGESTION: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. IF VOMITING OCCURS SPONTANEOUSLY KEEP HEAD BELOW HIPS TO PREVENT INHALATION. SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IMMEDIATELY. IF A PERSON VOMITS WHILE LYING ON BACK PLACE HIM IN THE RECOVERY POSITION. PREVENT ASPIRATION OF VOMIT. TURN VICTIM'S HEAD TO THE SIDE. SECTION VI - REACTIVITY DATA

HAZARDOUS POLYMERIZATION: Will not occur under normal conditions.

STABILITY: This product is stable under normal storage conditions.

SECTION VII - SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN CASE MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED: WARNING! ELIMINATE ALL IGNITION SOURCES. HANDLING EQUIPMENT MUST BE GROUNDED TO PREVENT SPARKING. VENTILATE THE AREA USING EXPLOSION PROOF VENTILATION. DO NOT BREATHE FUMES.
